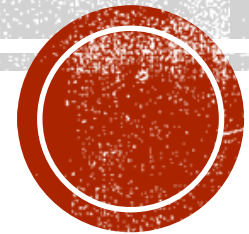


KARNAUGH MAPS

SUMMARY OF GROUPING RULES

- A group must contain only 1's
- Groups are formed only horizontally or vertically
- Groups contain cells in 2^n (1,2,4,8,...)
- Each Group should be as large as possible
- Groups can overlap
- Think of the grid as rolled on a cylinder – they can wrap from bottom up to top
- All the 1's must be in at least one group (thus, you may have a single 1 group)
- Group the 1's to make as few groups as possible
